Referendum to be held on: Thursday 20th July 2023 @ the Village Hall Examination Passed!

The Plan was submitted in February and examined in March by an independent examiner, Andrew Ashcroft, appointed by West Lindsey District Council (WLDC) in consultation with the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group. He recommended some changes, which strengthened and improved the Plan but retained all policies from the Submission Draft.

Neighbourhood Plan will have genuine legal weight

A final version of the Keelby Neighbourhood Plan, if supported at the referendum, will become part of the "Development Plan" and it will have genuine influence over planning in the Parish because it will be a "Material Consideration" in planning decisions.

What happens next?

The Referendum is open to registered voters in Keelby Parish and will be organised by the elections team at WLDC who will send out your polling card in the usual way. The question that you will be asked to vote on is.

'Do you want West Lindsey District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Keelby to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?'
